



I take this opportunity to welcome and thank all the parents who have respond their faith in our school. We try our best to maintain the highest quality of education and provide wonderful environment for studies.





GENERAL RULES AND REGULATION FOR THE PARENTS AND STUDENTS

ADMISSION RULES

The Academic session is from April to March.

An admission test is taken during admission time to ascertain the grade to which a student may be admitted.

Parents / guardians are instructed to fill in the forms with utmost accuracy. No changes will be permitted thereafter for any reason whatsoever.

A transfer certificate will be required from the candidates coming from another school.

FEES PAYMENT RULES

The school reserves the right to amend policies, rules and modify the fee structure from time to time without prior notice.

Both online and cash payment of school fees will be accepted Advance payment of fees will be accepted.

Those seeking admission in the mid-session shall have to pay the fees from the beginning of the session itself.

After every 3 month a fine of Rs. 300/- will be charged for late payment of tuition fee and transportation fee separately and it will remain a mandatory pay.

DISCIPLINARY RULES

Speaking in English is compulsory for the students within the campus. Students found speaking other language, use of foul and unparliamentarily language are liable to disciplinary action.

No student is allowed to leave the school premise or sent home alone during school hours without explicit permission of the principal. In case of urgent need, a duly authorised person should come to fetch him / her with a note of authority from the parents / guardians.

In no way should students disfigure the walls of the school. Any damage done to the school property will be compensated by the pupil concerned.

Students should come to school neatly dressed (clean uniform, nails trimmed, shoes polished, proper haircut).

Students are not allowed to bring any articles like cell phones, E-gazettes, jewellery, caps, fashionable clips, non prescribed books, materials. If found any will lead to fine and punishment. Smoking and chewing gums, gutkha, pan masala are strictly prohibited on the school premise.

Students are expected to bring home made tiffin and parents are requested to discourage students to bring money and buy outside food.

Parents/guardians are not allowed to meet their wards during school hours.

SCHOOL RULES

Every student is expected to attend the school regularly and an time punctuality and regularity in attendance is essential.

Entry into school premise is not permitted before 9:00 a.m. Morning assembly is conducted from 9:30 a.m. Latest comers will not be allowed to enter the school and will be sent home at the risk of parents / guardians. The school will not take any responsibility in such cases.

All leaves must be applied in writing to principal. Leave application and leave record should be duly signed by the parents / guardians.

No student is allowed to leave the classroom without the permission of the teacher.

Students are not allowed to apply m hendi, wear jewellery or have their nails polished etc. Smoking and chewing gums, gutkha, pan-masala are strictly prohibited in the school premise.

The school is not responsible for the goods lost by the students. They are advised not to bring any expensive article or money to school.

Any kind of disrespectful behaviour, bullying, spreading rumours etc. will lead to disciplinary action. Disobedience and disrespectful behaviour is prohibited.

School diary and identity card should be brought to school daily.

WITHDRAWAL / EXPULSION RULES

Before withdrawal a student from the school, a months prior notice or application should be written to the principal/authority.

No school leaving certificate will issue unless requested in writing by the parents and all dues should be cleared. A prescribed fee should be deposited along with the application.

The principal and school management board reserved the right to expel a student, who fails to make satisfactory progress in his/her studies or whose conduct is in anyway, detrimental to the discipline of the institution, for immorality, insubordination or contempt, without prior notice to the parents.

A minimum of 75% attendance is compulsory to be eligible to appear in the examination. The school reserved the authority to restrain the admit card and can cancel the promotion process.

CONVEYANCE RULES

The use of the school bus available to the student cannot be expected or demanded as a matter of right.

The School reserves the right to withdraw transport services of any transport fee defaulter after 3 months.

Vehicle charge will be paid for 12 months (including holiday) of calendar year. School reserves the right to change / revise vehicle fee as per hike in diesel cost and other expense.

Student provided vehicle service cannot cancel the same in the mid of the session is must.

Students need to be punctual at the pickup points. Parents are requested to bring the child at least 10 minutes before the prescribed time.

Students while travelling on the bus school vehicle must maintain discipline. Student / Parents / Guardians will not have any transaction altercation / Physical fight with the bus staff.
